The Rosa Parks Take Action Club (TAC) is a student organization that promotes leadership through service in our local and global communities. The club is run by fourth and fifth grade students who express interest by submitting the attached application. We will accommodate as many students as possible and are looking for students who are committed to the program and will be able to participate the entire year.

The Take Action Club partners with WE Charities, a non-profit organization, and is sponsored by the PTSA. It is overseen by two volunteer parent coordinators.

Applicants should have a strong interest in learning about local and global issues, serving others, leading fellow students in meaningful projects, and of course, having fun! Participants must intend to attend all regularly scheduled meetings, which will be held two Mondays a month after school. Additional optional opportunities will be available after school and on the weekends. **IMPORTANT:** Students with 2 or more unexcused absences during a term may be asked to leave the club.
